# OUR FARM

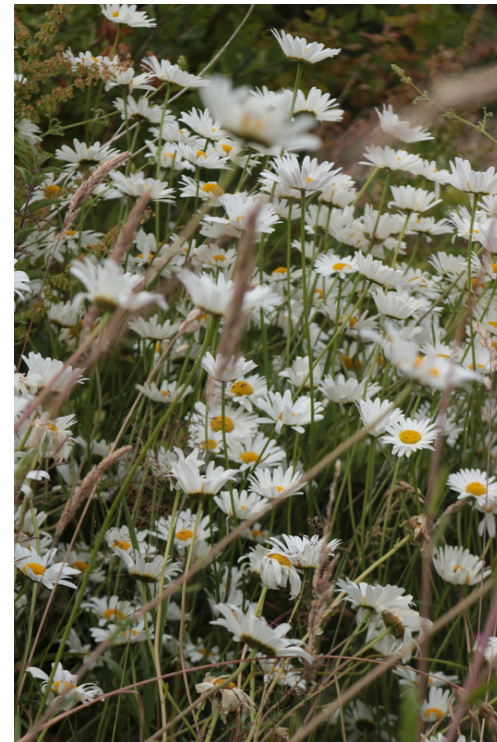
---

woodland, and a newly planted  
vineyard.

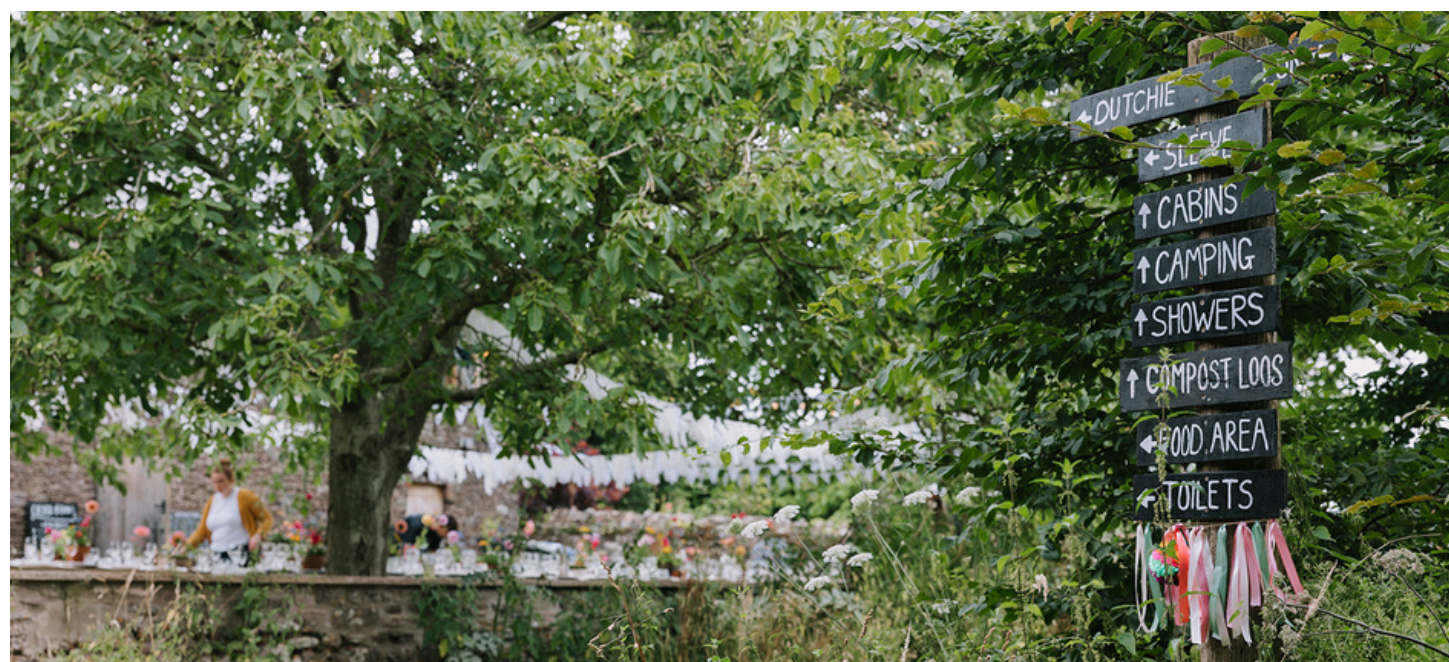




# YOUR WEDDING DAY

# BOTTOM POOL

---

Nestled in the lower part of the farm, the bottom pool is an intimate, quiet spot for your ceremony - no need for microphones as the land itself creates a natural amphitheatre. The wild pool is bursting with flora and fauna. Your guests will be seated on a mixture of benches and hay bales to create a rustic feel, with our ancient flower arch decorated by the wedding party as the centerpiece.







# THE TON

The oldest and one of the most cherished buildings on the farm, The Ton provides a beautiful indoor alternative for your ceremony in a wonderfully rural setting.





# THE LAWN

---

Set in front of our stone farmhouse, The Lawn looks out across the rolling pasture and natural pools at the centre of the farm. The perfect spot to welcome your guests with bubbles, botanical drinks and canapés.





# THE SLEEVE

---

The Sleeve is our 400-year-old converted main event barn. The ground floor provides a one-of-a-kind party zone, complete with a high-end sound system, a dancefloor, a staffed and licensed bar stocked with our own perry, tap beer from Bristol Beer Factory, and a selection of spirits and soft drinks.

The upper level offers a kitchen that can be hired for use by the wedding party for Friday dinner, Saturday breakfast and Sunday breakfast.

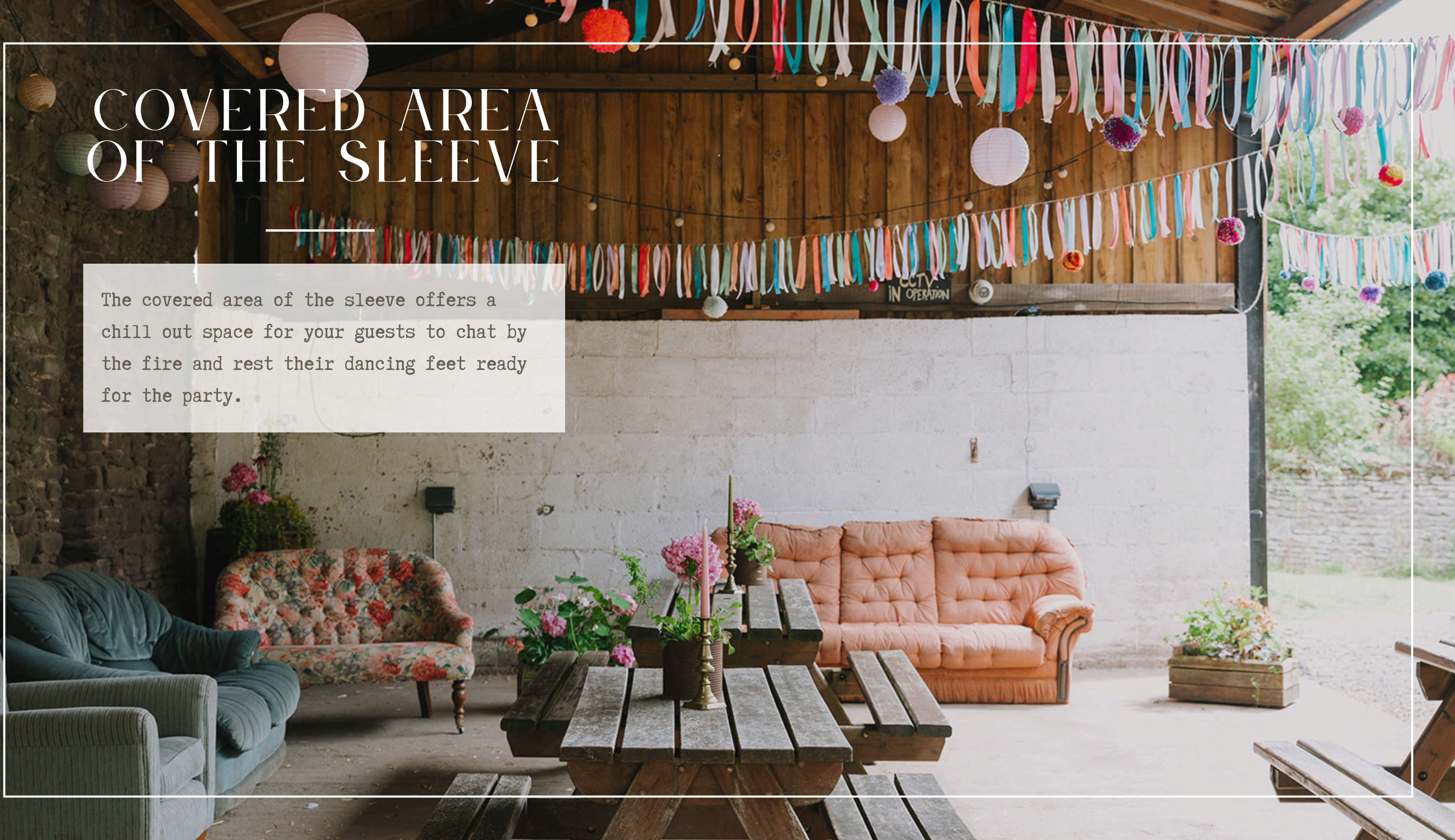
# UNDER THE WALNUT TREES

# THE CEREMONY

---

A unique and versatile space for your wedding, the farm lends itself to an exciting range of personalised experiences, with space for up to 200 people.

We provide a decorative wooden flower arch that can be situated in various locations and whichever space you choose for your ceremony, we will provide long wooden benches and hay bales ready for your guests.

We look forward to welcoming you for a visit, where we will take a walk around the farm to discover which spaces you are most drawn to.



# FOOD AND DRINK

---

Food is at the heart of what we do - we love giving our guests a taste of the land with our carefully curated menus. Where possible we work with the abundance our farm offers and partner with local growers who provide fresh, seasonal produce.

We raise heritage breed livestock - Badger Face sheep, Belted Galloway cows and Large Black pigs - all of which play an important role in both our land management and the food that we offer.





Cooking over fire is one of our specialties and the outdoor fire kitchen is often a focal point of our dining experiences. Whether it's a whole sheep, an exciting array of vegetables or a delicious plant-based option, we are fully equipped to deliver a unique wedding breakfast for you and your guests.



Our talented in-house chefs offer a mezze buffet, served in one of our renovated barns or in an externally hired marquee by our Front of House team. We provide sample menus on request and would be delighted to discuss these with you.

We make our own botanical drinks with ingredients foraged from the land and make apple juice and perry from our orchard. We have excellent relationships with local breweries and wine merchants and offer a curated selection of wines, beers and ciders. If you would like to source and supply your own alcoholic beverages, we offer a corkage fee.







# THE PARTY!

---

Our stone barn nightclub, the Sleeve, is a fantastic venue for a party. With great acoustics, a fully stocked and staffed bar, Void sound system and a license to party until 4AM makes it the perfect place for DJs to take the celebration well into the night. The Dutchie space on the other hand is perfect for a live band or even a ceilidh.

# ECO CABINS

---

Our hand-built, cosy eco-cabins are crafted from local timber and feature eco-slates, hemp walls and a view across our vineyard. One of these furnished cabins will be reserved for the wedding couple and included in the land hire fee, with two others exclusively available for hire by your family or friends.



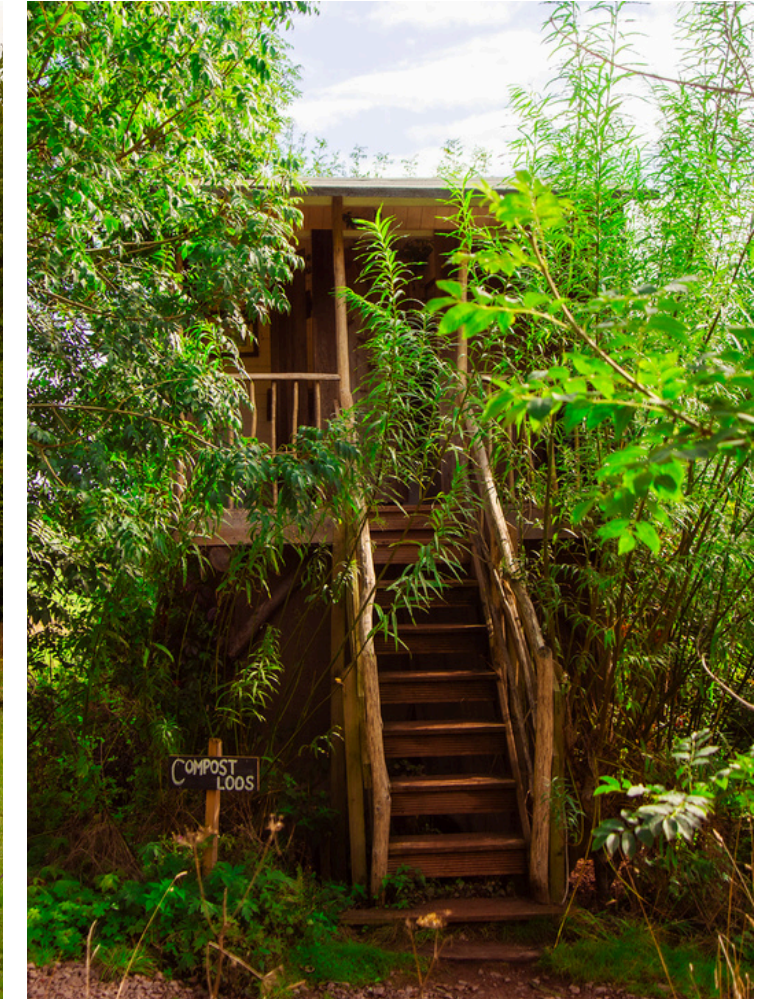


# GLAMPING & CAMPING

---

We offer a designated camping field with 15 glamping bell tents available for hire. Our bell tents are fully equipped, featuring four single beds with bedding, sheepskin rugs, hand crafted wooden tables and lights.

Guests are also welcome to bring their own tent. Adjacent to the camping field are compost toilets and hot showers.





# SUSTAINABILITY

Sustainability plays a fundamental role here at Three Pools. Our efforts towards a sustainable future and the regenerative practices that inform them are constantly evolving, but here are just a few of the ways in which we strive to make a difference.

## PERMACULTURE & LAND USE

Our livestock are reared using organic and permaculture principles to improve soil and ecosystems across 141 acres of pasture and woodland. Our farming system sequesters over 200% of the carbon it emits, and profits from our events are reinvested into the land.

## FARM TO TABLE

We grow a selection of fruit, vegetables and herbs on the farm, press and bottle our own apple juice, and rear and butcher our own meat – reducing food miles, packaging and waste. Our vineyard, planted in 2021, uses low-intervention techniques to nurture long-term soil health.

## WASTE & RECYCLING

We minimise waste through reusable cups, keg beer, compostable packaging and on-site recycling. Food waste is composted and returned to our vegetable garden. Our long drop compost toilets reduce waste transport and return nutrients to the land through surrounding willow.

## LONG TERM VISION

Three Pools is an attempt to scale up permaculture practices used in farming. We have planted over 450m of new hedgerows and over 2ha of new woodland. We engage in biodiversity surveys and research on the farm so that we can study our impact on wildlife in the long term.
